**TUITION:** Tuition costs cover approximately 80% of our total operating expenses.

*Families who pay the entire annual **tuition** amount by August 1 will receive a 5% discount. \*\*You must notify the office in advance. This is non-refundable, so please use a payment plan if you anticipate relocation. \*\**

**Part-Time Students Option:**

Students 2<sup>nd</sup> grade and up may take individual classes at Imago Dei Academy. These classes include, but are not limited to art/drama, math, Latin, Omnibus, and science. Please check with the administrator to see which classes are being offered for this school year. **Monthly tuition is \$110 per course for part-time students. Omnibus for grades 9-11 is \$150 monthly. Applicable book fees will be added to the account.**

Multiple Child Tuition Discount:

- 2<sup>nd</sup> child enrolled full time: 10% discount
- 3<sup>rd</sup> child enrolled full time: 15% discount
- 4<sup>th</sup> child enrolled full time: 20% discount
- 5<sup>th</sup> child or more full time: 25% discount

Full-time Occupational Ministers' Discount: 10%

**Fees:** \$55.00 covers a portion of RenWeb alerts, and the annual FACTS processing fee per family.

There may be certain costs involved with some activities such as field trips, classroom art projects, athletics, etc. These costs will be billed separately throughout the school year as incurred.



## **Books:**

Book fees depend on publisher pricing and may fluctuate from year to year. One-half of the **book fee** and the **enrollment fee** is due upon acceptance or in conjunction with the first tuition payment. The second installment is due no later than July 1. Students enrolling after July 1 will pay half of the book fee, the enrollment fee, and the first tuition payment upon acceptance. The book fee includes standardized testing for 3<sup>rd</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> grades.

**SHOP with SCRIP:** Mandatory \$500 Scrip card purchase with optional buy-out of \$70.00 per family. Families have from July 1 to April 1 of the current school year to meet this amount. Families not reaching the minimum amount will have \$70.00 automatically applied to their account.

IDA utilizes the SCRIP program throughout the school year to maintain affordable tuition rates. Families simply purchase shopping cards through the Scrip Program for physical and online vendors all over the country (Walmart, Albertsons, Amazon, Chilis, clothing stores, etc.). There are no additional fees associated with the cards, as they are each worth their face value. However, as participants in the SCRIP program, these retailers have agreed to give a portion back to IDA in cash. With consistent use of the program, we have the potential to raise enough funds equal a teacher's annual salary or more.
